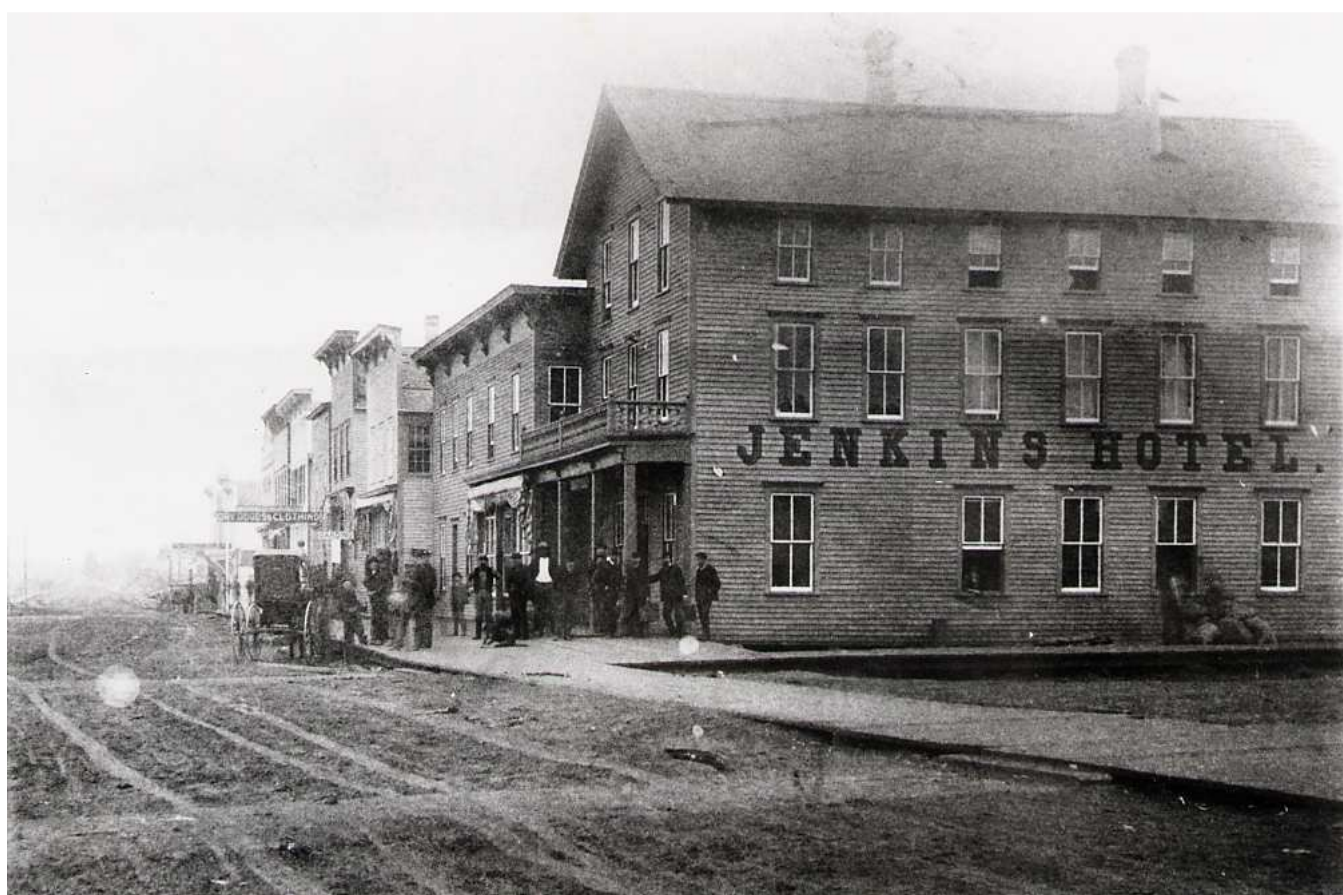

The camera is facing north on Stephenson Avenue in the mid-1880's in this view of the east side of the 200 block where the First National Bank is now located. William H. Jenkins opened his hotel at the corner of South Stephenson Avenue and East Ludington Street in early November, 1881. The three-story frame hotel was considered the city's finest, rooms renting for \$2.00 per day in 1885, about the time this photograph was taken. *[Menominee Range Historical Museum]*
