Workmen were boxing in the mine creek which ran along the side of Iron Mountain’s West Hughitt Street from Merritt Avenue west in mid-June, 1891, to “prevent children from throwing debris into the water,” according to *The Iron Range*. The camera faces east, and this unidentified city crew was working at the northwest corner of Carpenter Avenue and Hughitt Street.
